

Some places to eat in the area

There are several restaurants in the neighbouring village Englefield Green and the town of Egham.

The main shopping area in Englefield Green is on St Jude's Road and Victoria Street. Some of the restaurants there:

- Indian restaurant: "Megna Carta Tandoori". 2 St Judes Road, Englefield Green, Egham, TW20 0DB. Tel.: 01784 437397.
- Italian restaurant: "Soprano" (formerly "The Don Beni"). 9 St Judes Road, Englefield Green, TW20 0BY. Tel.: 01784 477784.

Some pubs also serve food (the closest one is Monkey's Head across the A30 from the campus, but there are plenty of pubs around).

The main shopping area in Egham is High Street, with several restaurants, including:

- Scottish fish restaurant: "Loch Fyne". 5-6 High Street, Egham. Tel.: 01784 414890.

- “The Fox & Hounds” (near Windsor Great Park). Bishopsgate Road, Englefield Green, Egham, TW20 0XU. Tel.: 01784 433098.
- “Edwinns Bar & Grill” (Windsor Great Park). Wick Road, Englefield Green, Surrey TW20 0HN. Tel.: 01784 477877.
- Chinese: “Lux II”. 16 Station Approach, Virginia Water, Surrey GU25 4DW. Tel.: 01344 845177. There are several other restaurants nearby.
- “Great Fosters”. Stroude Road, Egham, Surrey TW20 9UR. Tel.: 01784 433822.
- Sir Christopher Wren’s House (Strok’s Restaurant). Thames Street, Windsor, Berkshire SL4 1PX. Tel.: 1753 861354. There are many other restaurants in Windsor (High Street) and Eton (High Street).

It should take no more than 10 minutes by car to any of these restaurants (for most of them, it is a 5-minute journey). The last two restaurants are rather posh (and expensive).
